### Horsham North by Parish/Ward – 12 months Crime Comparison to 31<sup>st</sup> January 2013

This comparison shows that the number of reported incidents in the Parish of Nuthurst has dropped by 11 from the previous year. From 18 Wards/Parishes Nuthurst is the third lowest in reported incidents.

**Farm Watch** - For those that live in very rural locations it may be practical to be part of a Neighbourhood Watch Scheme, so it is suggested that you may consider joining Sussex Farm Watch. This title may be misleading in that you do not have to live on a farm to become a member. ## The smart way to report highway issues

Love West Sussex is a new idea which makes it quicker and easier for you to report problems on and around our roads.

These include potholes, overgrown vegetation, damaged signs, graffiti, fly-tipping, broken paving and blocked road drains.

You can report problems online at [www.westsussex.gov.uk](http://www.westsussex.gov.uk). Just click on the Love West Sussex logo which is on the bottom left hand side of the home page.

We have improved the online system to make it even quicker and easier. Once you have signed up for an account, which includes providing an email address, you can opt to receive feedback on progress and do not need to re-enter your details each time you report a problem.

Submitting a report is a three stage process

- Pinpoint the location on the map
- Choose a category, adding as much detail in the free text as you can
- Upload a photo of the problem

The Love West Sussex internet pages include a live map showing all the current reports across West Sussex and you can also view those that have been resolved. When you send your report make sure you include details of size. If you are reporting a pothole



you could estimate the width and depth, for example, as deep as a coke can or the size of a tennis ball.

We make a decision on the type and timescale of a pothole repair based on a set of factors including consideration of depth, width and safety impact. The more detail you provide, the easier it is for us to deal with your reported concern.
