HEALTH & LEISURE WALKS

All welcome to guided, **free**, sociable, HDC walks led by trained volunteers; no need to book, just turn-up at the start point. All walks can be wet and muddy in places. Forthcoming walks in the Nuthurst Parish and neighbouring areas are as follows:-

Every Sunday & Wednesday 2:30pm: Horsham Welcome Walks A 2 mile walk taking 90 minutes Meet at the Museum in the Causeway. Horsham is a lovely place to live but do you know much about its history? Fri 10 & 24 June 11:00am: Southwater (1) A 2½ mile flat circular walk along bridleways, country lanes and the Downs Link.. Meet in the Country Park car park (off Cripplegate Lane) RH13 7UN TQ 161258. Not suitable for wheelchairs, buggies and prams, can be muddy. Dogs allowed on a lead. 1¼ hours. Walkers can choose to walk for 30 or 75 minutes. The Park café will be open for refreshments at the end if you wish. **Leader: Chatter Cheema 07720 714306**

Sat 18 June 10:00am: Roosthole (2). Park in the Forestry Commission car park on Hammerpond Road, RH13 6PG (TQ208298). This 3½ mile walk, taking 1¾ hours, will most likely be muddy and slippery. The walk is through open paths and wooded areas with some steep inclines to increase your heart rate. We may encounter dogs and horses. Sun 19 & 26 June 10:30am: Leechpool and Owlbeech Woods A lovely woodland 2¼ mile walk, taking 1¼ hours, generally following main paths and easy under foot, although a small part of the walk will be on narrower paths with tree roots, stubs and uneven ground. Some inclines. Can be muddy in places. A sensible pair of shoes would be advisable. Dogs on a lead are welcome An optional short 30 minute walk is always available. Meet at Leechpool Wood car park, Horsham (TQ194313), off Harwood Road (B2195).**Leader: Armelle 01403 260342**

Tue 21 June 10:00am: Warninglid – Crabtree Wealden Iron Industry Lakes, 5¾ mile circular walk, through woods and farmland, past lakes and furnace ponds. No stiles but a few, short, fairly steep hills Good views. Meet at the **Half Moon car park, Warninglid** (TQ 250260). No dogs. 2¾ hours. **Leader Geoff 01403 258180**

Tue 21 June 6:30pm: The Windmill Inn, Partridge Green A 5 mile walk, taking 2½ hours, leads us through fields that could be muddy, along the Downs Link and through woodland towards Shermanbury, with views of St Hughs Charterhouse monastery. Possibility of livestock. Sorry no dogs. Meet / park on Littleworth Lane, RH13 8EJ (TQ193205). From the A272 between Buck Barn and Cowfold turn onto Littleworth Lane, this will lead you to the Windmill Inn. Sat 25 June 10:00am: Leechpool & Owlbeech Woods Extended Walk Meet at Leechpool Wood car park, Harwood Rd B2195, Horsham (TQ194313). Lovely 3½ mile woodland walk, taking 1¾ hours which passes a couple of ponds. Some inclines, narrow paths, a bit challenging at times, with tree roots, stumps and uneven ground. Can be muddy. Wed 29 June 2:30pm: Chesworth Amble. A gentle 2 mile amble along the new Riverside Walk into Chesworth Farm, taking a look at the new path and bird hides and then a stroll back in time for a coffee or lunch at the Garden centre, taking one hour. No dogs. Meet at Hillier Garden Centre site, Brighton Road, Horsham, RH13 6QA (TQ187296), on the gravel farthest away from the entrance. **Leader: Jill Shuker 07780 701184**

Thu 30 June 10:00am: George & Dragon, Dragons Green. A 5 ¾ mile circular walk near Shipley, (the pub with a gravestone in the garden), on undulating Wealden tracks and through woodland. Meet in pub car park (TQ 139235). Good beer and excellent food. No dogs. 2 ¾ hours. **Leader Geoff 01403 258180**
